To be eligible for the Working Holiday Visa

- You must be a Canadian citizen and residing in Canada with a valid Canadian passport (minimum 6 weeks past the end date of your stay in Japan).
- You must be between the ages of 18 and 30 years (inclusive).
- You must be in good health.
- You must have a clear Police Record.
- You must provide proof of financial resources \$3,500 CAD to provide for any initial expenses at the start of your stay and to allow you to leave the country at any time.
- You must submit all the documents necessary to support vour visa request.
- You have not held a Working Holiday Visa for Japan before.



- There are no visa fees.
- Financial Proof: \$3,500 CAD (doesn't have to be spent)

What is NOT included

- Flight tickets
- Personal Expenses
- Visa Costs (e.g., travel to Japanese consulate)
- Medical Travel Insurance (mandatory)

Program Eligibility

- You must be eligible for the Working Holiday Visa for Canadian Citizens with no dependents. The duration of this visa is up to 12 months.
- You must have International Travel Medical Insurance for the entire duration that you are in Japan.
- For most job guarantees, basic Japanese skills are required (we recommend the Gold Package with 4 weeks Japanese lessons).





Visa Application Process

- You are allowed to stay in Japan for 6 months. Once in Japan, you will be able to apply for another 6 month extension (cost: 4,000 Yen).
- You will have to apply for the visa in person at one of the following locations: Vancouver, Calgary, Toronto, Montreal, Ottawa.
- If you are a resident of BC or Yukon, GO International is able to apply for the visa on your behalf.
- It usually takes 1 week for the Japanese consulate/embassy to process your Working Holiday visa.
