Powhiri on Arrival

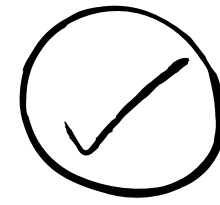
A Powhiri is a traditional Maori welcome ceremony and we want to make sure this is one of the first things participants experience on arrival

Work with Local Iwi or other Maori Providers

Providers of Maori Tourism experiences should be local Maori wherever possible

We have worked with local Iwi (Tribes) to host a forum with young Maori to meet with program participants in a facilitated forum. We will discuss issues that young people face in both NZ and Canada, share stories and ideas on how to manage these issues

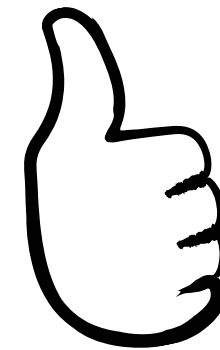
Visit Companies and Organisations

An important part of this program for Canadian Indigenous youth is to meet with companies and government organisations that integrate Maori Tikanga in to day to day practices

Tupu Toa - aims to increase representation of Maori in leadership roles in the corporate sector

Tataki Unlimited - is working with local Iwi (Tribes) to preserve sacred sites but still allow tourism in a culturally appropriate way

BNZ Bank - is currently reviewing all business practicses to incorporate Maori Tikanga in everything they do

A Traditional Maori Powhiri on arrival is an important start to the

Manuhiri (visitors) are viewed as “tapu” (sacred or set apart from the everyday/normal things). The pōwhiri is viewed as a process of removing the “tapu” and making everyone “noa” (equal). The sharing of food is the final act of this process and therefore the pōwhiri is concluded with a light refreshment
